Includes crossing improvements (Campbell, Euclid) Traffic calming complicated by stormwater runoff but hopefully a traffic circle at Warren and other improvements at Park including plantings and flanked by speed humps ETA Spring 2024.

Tucson DOT response to Joe's question: We need to contact COT Director of Transportation to say:

"RHNA want streets repaved with conventional asphalt paving. We do not want any form of chipsealing." msp [Out neighborhood streets are far more heavily used than other neighborhood streets due to UA, including UA sports.]
